FUND COMMENTARY

Many investors are surprised by the strong performance from the equity markets this year – especially those who took fright towards the end of last year and opted for the proverbial side-lines. We were clear on our views at the time.

A frequent error some make in commenting on performance is by considering data points versus preceding trough levels. We are of the opinion that one should also consider performance levels against preceding peak levels. In this context, interestingly, the MSCI World AC index (\$-terms) has grown +32.3% p.a. since its trough level during the Credit Crisis, whilst its growth since the preceding peak level has been only +1.8% p.a. (respectively +15.6% p.a. and +5.6% p.a. for the S&P 500 index). In terms of the short term experience, the MSCI World AC index is up +20.3% since its December 2018 trough, but still -4.6% lower than its January 2018 peak (+25.3% since the December trough for the S&P 500, and by just +0.5% surpassing its September 2018 peak). From a technical point of view, these numbers do not yet reflect a structurally overheated equity market.

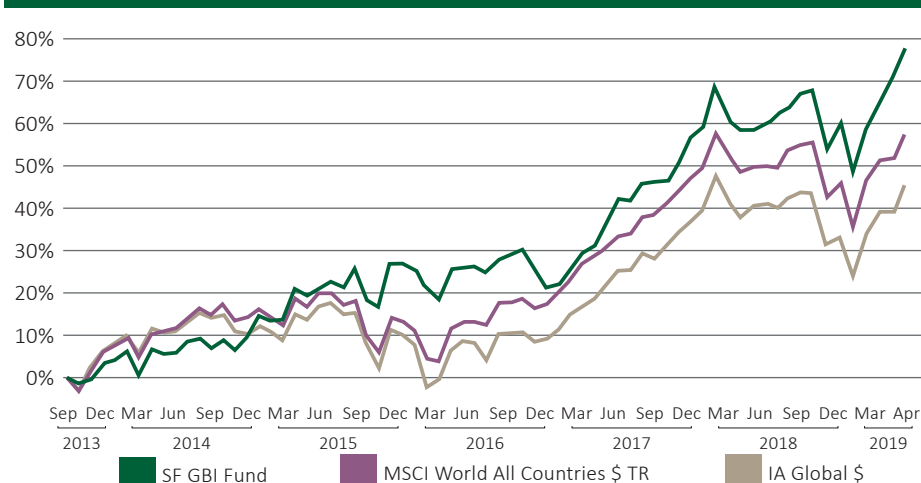
There are a number of fundamental issues that have changed over the past quarter. Leading US economic indicators have started rolling over in the fourth quarter of last year, but have since stabilised at constructive levels. Inflation levels and interest rates remain lower than many feared a few months ago. The US yield curve has not inverted as many feared it may do, and has actually stabilised in constructive territory. Both US and China economic growth in the first quarter exceeded expectations. Whilst expectations for continuing economic expansion have been tempered, the outlook for continuing earnings growth for quality businesses remains on course.

The dull but constructive economic outlook allays many fears around excessive volatility in the capital markets. A conclusion on the Sino-US trade negotiations may also be appreciated.

The Company is recognised as a section 264 scheme by the Financial Conduct Authority in the United Kingdom. The Fund is an approved Foreign Collective Investment Scheme in South Africa where it is registered with the Financial Sector Conduct Authority (South Africa). The Fund has been granted consent pursuant to the Control of Borrowing (Jersey) Order 1958, by the Jersey Financial Services Commission ("JFSC") to circulate an offer for subscription,

sale or exchange of shares in Jersey. The JFSC is protected by the Control of Borrowing (Jersey) Law 1947, as amended, against liability arising from the discharge of its functions under that Law. Link Fund Administrators (Ireland) Limited has been appointed as the manager (the "Manager") of the Company and Stonehage Fleming Investment Management Limited has been appointed as the investment manager (the "Investment Manager") of the Company.
