

PORTFOLIO COMMENTARY

The Global Multi-Asset Portfolio A USD Class returned -2.1% in October vs -2.2% for the benchmark. Equities and bonds fell in October as strong US economic data reinforced the 'higher for longer' interest rate narrative that has been driving bond yields higher over recent months. The tragic events unfolding in the Middle East also dampened market sentiment and supported gains for oil and gold.

The equity book posted negative returns and trailed broader equity markets. Our blended approach to holding companies across the market cap spectrum was a headwind in the month as smaller companies underperformed; this particularly impacted our holdings in US small cap manager, Driehaus, and global small cap manager, Dimensional. The holding in the SF Global Best Ideas Fund (GBI) was one of the best relative performers in the month, largely due to good performance from technology and consumer companies. Insurance was an area of strength as the Polar Insurance Fund posted positive returns in a weak market; the reinsurance positions were the standout performers in the month.

The fixed income book delivered negative returns as sovereign yields climbed and credit spreads widened. It was a strong month for our Alternatives book with positive returns from all positions. Gold was a standout contributor as investors sought safety from falls in equities and bonds.
