We are dedicated to supporting local communities and charities in the geographies in which we operate, below are some of the highlights from the past 6 months.

In South Africa the team made donations to iBohdi Trust, <u>United Jewish Campaign (UJC)</u>, <u>Children A</u> Loud and Princess Alice Adoption Home.



iBhodi Trust

The iBhodi philosophy is that learners should get access to high quality teaching regardless of where they live. Their solution is an online learning model employing only the best and highest qualified teachers. Stonehage Fleming has been supporting iBhodi since 2019. This year some of the funds will be applied to assist with much needed marketing material needed for fundraising. Stonehage Fleming also acts as Trustees for iBhodi Trust. Read more.

<u>The United Jewish Campaign (UJC)</u> is the Cape Town Jewish Community's umbrella fundraising body and sets out to ensure the wellbeing, development and sustainability of the Cape Town Jewish community.













<u>Princess Alice Adoption Home (PAAH)</u> is a temporary place of safety which provides 24 hour residential care to babies who have been consented for adoption, abandoned or occasionally removed from family care. In celebration of Youth Day, our Johannesburg team delivered baby products, cleaning products and treats for the toddlers.

On 16 June, the team in Cape Town delivered food to 52 children as part Kommetjie based charity 'Children A Loud's' Youth Day programme. Children A Loud's main objectives are to identify and support youth at risk within the socially deprived community of Ocean View, in the aim of enabling young people to bring about change within their lives through daily positive reenforcement, building of resilience and decreasing risk taking behaviour.



In Jersey the team continue to support a number of local Charites including Mind Jersey, Shelter Trust, Beresford Street Kitchen, Jersey Hospice Care and Autism Jersey. Highlights for the past 6 months include donations to The Jersey Women's Refuge, Jersey Brain Tumour Charity and Jersey Action Against Rape. The team also joined over 1,300 islanders to mark the 30th anniversary of Jersey's Around the Island Walk – one of the island's largest one-day fundraising events.



<u>The Jersey Women's Refuge</u> is the only independent domestic violence charity in Jersey, it provides a 24-hour, confidential service, which offers practical and emotional support to women and children suffering from abuse.

<u>Jersey Brain Tumour Charity</u> assists patients, families, relatives and friends of anyone affected by a brain tumour diagnosis in Jersey.





<u>Jersey Action Against Rape</u> is an independent and confidential service helping people to recover from the trauma of sexual violence.

The Around the Island Walk was born in 1991 when 15 intrepid walkers embarked on a clockwise walk around the Island's coastline starting and ending at Rozel. Since the event's inception, an overriding objective has been to ensure that every penny raised by walkers actually goes to local charities, and this objective remains one of the Trust's core values. Those who will benefit this year are Dementia Jersey, every child, SancTuary Trust, Durrell, Les Amis, Wetwheels Jersey, Caring Cooks, Healing Waves, Jersey Rescue Dogs and Pain Support Jersey. The MS Society fund world-leading research, share the latest information and campaign for everyone's rights. Their ultimate vision is a world free from the effects of MS.


